

Job Advert - Technical Production Operative

Ooznest Ltd are a rapidly expanding company that designs, manufactures and sells CNC Machines and parts.

We are looking for a dynamic **Technical Production Operative** to join our excellent team.

You will be a key member in our busy and friendly warehouse where you will be working on a variety of tasks, including the **preparation of our aluminium extrusion** for orders and managing some of the batch **production line of our CNC Machine kits**.

You will be responsible for:

- Operating large cutting machines to make custom length/ size cuts of aluminium extrusion and glass
- Using hand tools to drill tap finish materials
- Measuring completed workpieces to verify conformance to specifications
- Identifying and relaying any mistakes to be re-cut/corrected to the other operatives
- Carrying out all cutting tasks to the specified time standards
- Start up and checking all machines at the start of the day, monitoring their operations
- Learning about and supporting maintenance of the machines
- Developing knowledge about aluminium extrusion stock
- Complete required quality checks of materials, compare results against specified parameters, reporting issues
- Barcode scanning all materials, ensure finished items match order requirements
- Preparing materials for boxing using shrink wrap and foaming techniques to required standards
- Managing production of foam blocks using CNC machines
- Packing, boxing and labelling materials effectively for shipping using paper filling and strapping machines
- Managing the timescales and co-ordination of completion of orders and CNC kits
- Foreseeing any issues with the batch production
- Achieving maximum production output whilst maintaining defined quality standards and minimum waste
- Reporting batch progress to the Technical Operations and Production Managers
- Keeping work areas clean and tidy – managing extrusion stock levels and movement

- Accuracy & precision - to maintain high production output with little waste
- Attention to detail – to ensure a high quality standards of production
- Mechanical aptitude to use hand tools and machining
- Organisation – to ensure order and batch production times are met
- Communication – to coordinate with order production line team on batch progress
